Our vision to change the world began in the year 2000, when Mary Lou Krauseneck was diagnosed with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS), an incurable neuromuscular illness commonly known as Lou Gehrig's disease.

Her friends and family developed a campaign to raise awareness and fight the disease, thus beginning our A Passion for Life benefits. Over \$1.3 million dollars have been raised and donated to the ALS Therapy Development Institute (ALS TDI) of Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Since 1999, ALS TDI has built the first, largest and most comprehensive ALS screening program in the world, and tested nearly every known possible therapy. Using the open science model, every piece of information and innovation is shared with the scientific community to accelerate research.
